Ride Centro to the 2006 New York State Fair



Centro's State Fair Park-N-Ride service provided more than 211,000 rides during the 12-day event in 2005

Centro is again providing its popular direct service to the [2006 New York State Fair](#), August 24th- September 4th, from locations across Onondaga, Cayuga and Oswego Counties.

New this year, Centro is running service from Shoppingtown Mall every **half-hour!**

Centro passports and transfers will be accepted on all State Fair shuttles. Fares and times vary depending on location. Children 5 and under ride for free. Please take note of the following schedule and fare information.

[DOWNTOWN SYRACUSE SHUTTLE](#)

[Route #900](#)- provides express service from Common Center to the State Fair leaving from

the corner of Washington and Clinton Streets. The daily shuttle runs **continuously** to and from the Fairgrounds from 7 a.m. to midnight. The fare is \$1 for adults and teens, 50 cents for senior citizens 65 and over, disabled persons (with Centro or Medicare identification) and children ages 6 to 9.

[REGIONAL MARKET Route #905](#)- provides express service from the parking lot between the Regional Market and the Regional Transportation Center (located on Alliance Bank Parkway). The daily shuttle leaves the parking lot every 20 minutes beginning at 8:40am until Midnight. Returning shuttles leave the Main Gate at the State Fair every 20 minutes beginning at 9:00am until 12:15am. The fare is \$1 for adults and teens, 50 cents for senior citizens 65 and over, disabled persons (with Centro or Medicare identification) and children ages 6 to 9.

[FAIRMOUNT FAIR Route #904](#)- Leaving from the Park-N-Ride stop near the former Wal-Mart store every half hour, on the hour and on the half hour, from 9:00 a.m. to 11:30 p.m. and returns every half hour, on the hour and on the half hour, from 9:30 a.m. to midnight. Fare is \$1 each way, 50 cents for seniors and children, 6 to 9.

[SENECA MALL Route #907](#) - Leaving from the K-Mart Park-N-Ride at 20 minutes past the hour from 9:20 a.m. to 11:20 p.m. and returning 10 minutes before each hour from 9:50 a.m. to 10:50 p.m. and midnight. Fare is \$1.25 each way, 60 cents for seniors and children, 6 to 9.

[SHOPPINGTOWN MALL Route #906](#) - Leaving from the Northeast parking area every **half-hour** from 9:00 a.m. to midnight. Returning from the Fair every **half-hour** from 10 a.m. to midnight. Fare is \$1.25 each way, 60 cents for senior and children, 6 to 9.

[FINGERLAKES MALL Route #902](#) - Leaving from the Mall's rear east entrance on the hour from 8:00 a.m. to 7:00 p.m. Returning hourly from 10:00 a.m. to midnight. Fare is \$2.50 each way for adults, \$1.25 for seniors and children, 6 to 9.

[PORT BYRON Route #903](#) - Leaving the Village Office and Schasel Park at 9:30 and 11:30 a.m., 1:15, 3:15 and 5:15 p.m. Returning from the Fair hourly from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and every hour on the half hour from 5:30 p.m. to midnight. Fare is \$2.50 each way for adults, \$1.25 for seniors and children, 6 to 9 years old.

[WEEDSPORT Route #903](#) - Leaving the Jreck Subs at 9:40 a.m., 11:40 a.m., 1:20pm, 3:20, and 5:20 p.m. Returning from the Fair hourly from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and every hour on the half hour from 5:30 p.m. to midnight. Fare is \$2.50 each way for adults, \$1.25 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years old.

[ELBRIDGE Route #902](#) - Leaving Park-N-Ride at the Elbridge Fire Department on Main St. in the morning at 8:20a, 9:20, 9:50, 10:20, 11:20 and 11:50 a.m. and every hour at 15 minutes after the hour from 12:15 p.m. to 7:15 p.m. Returning from the Fair hourly from 10 a.m. to 4 p.m. and every hour on the half hour from 5:30 p.m. to midnight

Fare is \$2.00 each way for adults, \$1.00 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years old.

OSWEGO P & C PARKING LOT Route #908 - Leaving daily 8:50 a.m., 10:50 a.m., 12:50 p.m., 3:50 p.m. and 5:50 p.m. Returning at 12:00 noon, 2 p.m., 5 p.m., 7 p.m., 9:30 p.m., and 11:30 p.m. Fare is \$3.00 each way for adults, \$1.50 for seniors and children, 6 to 9 years old.

OSWEGO WEST 1ST & BRIDGE STREET Route #908 - Leaving at 9 a.m., 11 a.m., 1 p.m., 4 p.m., and 6 p.m. Returning from the State Fair at 12:00 noon, 2 p.m., 5 p.m., 7 p.m., 9:30 p.m., and 11:30 p.m. Fare is \$3.00 each way for adults, \$1.50 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years old.

FULTON TOWPATH TOWERS Route #908 - Leaving at 9:20 a.m., 11:20 a.m., 1:20 p.m., 4:20 p.m., and 6:20 p.m. Returning at 12 noon, 2 p.m., 5 p.m., 7 p.m., 9:30 p.m., and 11:30 p.m. Fare is \$2.50 each way for adults, \$1.25 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years of age.

PHOENIX, PHOENIX ISLAND Route #908 - Leaving at 9:35 a.m., 11:35 a.m., 1:35 p.m., 4:35 p.m., and 6:35 p.m. Returning at 12 noon, 2 p.m., 5 p.m., 7 p.m., 9:30 p.m., and 11:30 p.m. Fare is \$2.00 each way for adults, \$1.00 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years of age.

OSWEGO STATE COLLEGE SERVICE Route #908 - Leaving Hewitt Union four (4) days only; September 1st, 2nd, 3rd, and 4th. Buses will leave at 8:50 a.m., 10:50 a.m., 12:50 p.m., 3:50 p.m., and 5:50 p.m. Returning from the State Fair at 12:00 noon, 2:00 p.m., 5:00 p.m., 7:00 p.m., and 11:00 p.m. Fare is \$3.00 each way for adults, \$1.50 for seniors and children 6 to 9 years of age.

SYRACUSE UNIVERSITY SERVICE - Leaving Schine Student Center **Saturday September 2nd only**. Buses leave Schine Student Center, University Place, every half-hour from 10am-5:30pm. Buses return, leaving the State Fair Main Gate every half-hour from 11:30am-7:00pm. This service is free for Syracuse University students presenting a valid Syracuse University identification card.

Construction at St. Joseph's Hospital Forces Changes in Routes

Due to construction at St. Joseph's Hospital, Centro is changing the routing of all of its bus service to the hospital, effective immediately. The construction has forced the closure of parts of Prospect Avenue and Union Avenue near the hospital. The following Centro routes are affected:

#70/#170 Oak-Butternut:

This service will operate on Willow Street- to-Highland Street (and reverse) and will not travel on Prospect Avenue or Hickory Street. The nearest bus stop to the hospital will be the corner of Willow Street and Prospect Avenue. A shelter will be erected at that corner for Centro customers.

#80/#180 Grant Boulevard:

This service will operate Willow Street-North Townsend St-Laurel Street-Prospect Avenue-Butternut Street (and reverse). The nearest bus stop to the hospital will be the corner of Prospect Avenue/Laurel Street. Centro will erect a shelter at that corner. St Joseph's will provide signage to direct individuals to a non-emergency room entrance to the hospital.

#52 Court-Park St.

This service will operate Willow Street-North Townsend St-Laurel Street-Prospect Avenue-Butternut Street (and reverse). The nearest bus stop to the hospital will be the corner of Prospect Avenue/Laurel Street. Centro will erect a shelter at that corner. St Joseph's will provide signage to direct individuals to a non-emergency room entrance to the hospital. Centro advises all customers with mobility devices to use the #52, #80 or #180 routes, as they provide the closest and most accessible entrance to the hospital.
