## PROHIBITED ACTIVITIES & ITEMS

To ensure the safety of those using Centro's services or facilities, the following activities and items are prohibited on buses or facilities owned or operated by Centro or its subsidiaries:

1. Fare evasion, refusal to pay, forged fare media or identification.
2. Any activity that is considered in violation of New York State or Federal Law (e.g., assault, theft).
3. Vandalism, including graffiti, defacing, or damaging property.
4. Littering, urinating, defecating, or otherwise causing a public nuisance.
5. Smoking or vaping on company property.
6. Sleeping (where it is hazardous to such person and/or others, interferes with Centro's ability to carry out its responsibilities, or interferes with the comfort of others).
7. Gambling.
8. Playing loud music without headphones.
9. Throwing items on or from a bus, or on company property.
10. Possession of or consuming alcohol or illegal drugs.
11. Occupying more than one seat unnecessarily.
12. Blocking pedestrian traffic or the aisle unnecessarily.
13. Dangerous activity (e.g., skateboarding, hoverboarding, etc.)
14. Possessing illegal weapons or dangerous instruments.
15. Unauthorized commercial activity or restricted activity.
16. Extending arms or other body parts out of vehicle windows.
17. Unauthorized animals.
18. Failure to obey Centro employees or signs.

***NOTE: Violators may be suspended from using Centro transportation and facilities.***
