CENTRO ANNOUNCES AUBURN COMMUTER SERVICE CONSOLIDATIONS MADE DUE TO COVID-19 PANDEMIC TO BE PERMANENT

Auburn, NY – Centro’s consolidation of commuter bus services to enhance frequency on Centro’s most utilized bus route connecting Auburn and Syracuse due to the COVID-19 pandemic will be permanent.

During the COVID -19 pandemic, Centro redirected resources from its Route AUB8 Moravia, Route AUB7 Welch Allyn/Tessy and Route AUB38 Elbridge bus services to provide additional frequency on its AUB138/AUB236 Auburn-Skaneateles-Syracuse bus route.

As a result, Centro’s AUB8 Moravia, AUB7 Welch Allyn/Tessy and AUB38 Elbridge bus routes will be discontinued. Centro will continue to provide service to Welch Allyn along its AUB138 bus route.
