## **CENTRO TO RESTORE MORE BUS SERVICES ON NOVEMBER 8, 2021**

**Syracuse, NY** – Effective Monday, November 8, 2021, Centro will begin operating its Onondaga County bus service on a “modified weekday” schedule Monday through Friday. The modified weekday schedule features a return to limited service on all Centro bus lines, increased mid-day frequency on some bus lines, and earlier start times on daily transit services.

The new schedule includes:

- resumption of commuter bus service to Hancock Air Park, Minoa, Manlius, Tully, and Lafayette
- increased frequency on several mid-day bus lines
- route adjustments on the Sy 68 Erie Boulevard and Sy 82 Baldwinsville bus routes
- a 5:00 am start time for bus service from the Centro Transit Hub (more than an hour earlier than current service start-times)

“Though our workforce is not at full capacity, it has stabilized, and we are now able to confidently restore bus service that our customers can rely on daily,” said Vice President of Business Development & Corporate Communications, Steve Koegel.

“Since our decision to scale back services in September, we have re-constructed our service schedule to maximize the availability of our current workforce. The modified weekday schedule includes a creative approach to shortening some existing bus trips in order to increase the number of trips we can provide each day. We are continuing efforts to attract Bus Operators, which will allow us to restore more bus service in the future.”
