COVID-19 UPDATE

Syracuse, NY – A Centro Bus Operator has recently tested positive for COVID-19. The employee is a Syracuse Bus Operator who last worked on December 16, 2020.

We are working with the Onondaga County Health Department on their investigation and, at their direction, have notified Centro employees of this positive test. The Health Department is working to identify those individuals who may have been exposed and is contacting them to place them under quarantine.
