Reduced Fare ID Cards

Reduced Fare ID cards may be purchased for \$2.00 at the Centro Main office located at: 200 Cortland Ave, Syracuse, NY 13202 (Seniors will need to bring proof of age while Persons with Disabilities will need a Photo ID and an official document verifying their disability).

Find a time point on the map closest to where you want to catch the bus. Locate the letter above the timetable shown on the inside. Approximate times the bus will be at that stop are shown underneath each letter.

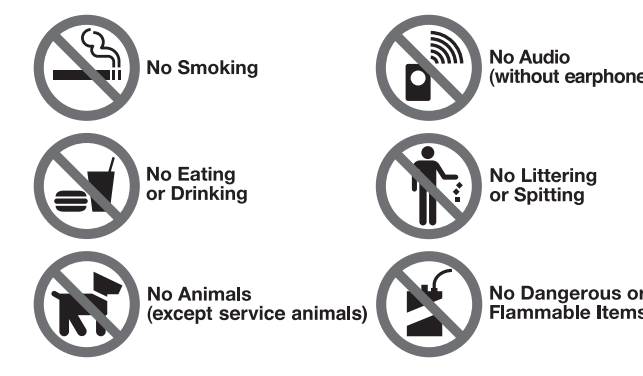
How to Ride

- Be at your designated bus stop prior to the scheduled departure time.
- Have exact fare ready.
- Pull on rope or push button for stop request.
- Be sure the bus comes to a complete stop before leaving your seat.

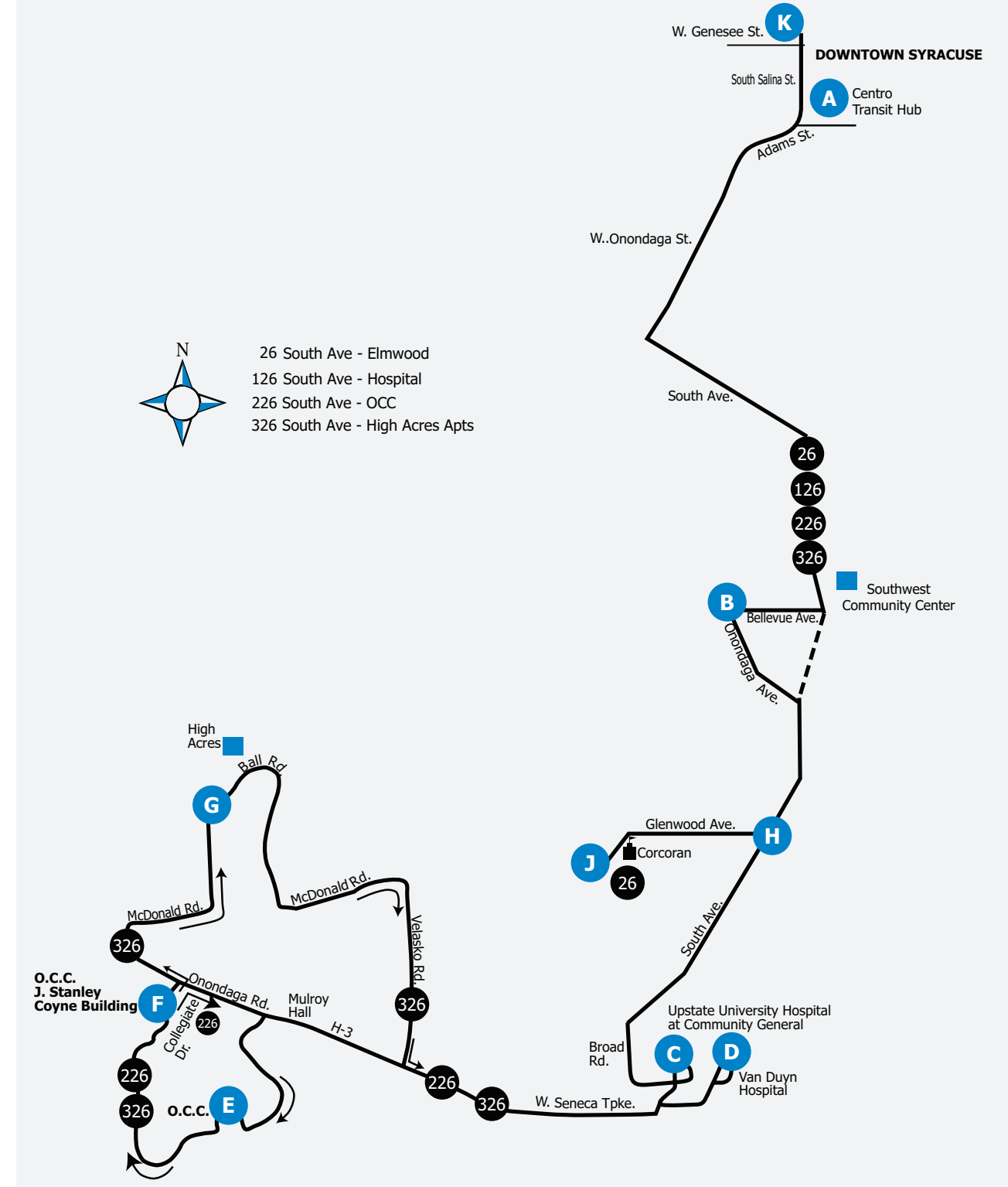
Transferring

You may transfer from one route to another route to complete a continuous one-way trip. As you board the first bus and pay your fare, ask the driver for a Transfer. When boarding the second bus, insert the Transfer into the farebox as payment of your fare. Please be aware that the transfers are issued with an expiration time, so you must board the first available bus at your transfer location. Transfers may not be used for return trips on the same line. Transfers do not count towards additional zone costs on your trip.

About Your Bus Route

The service described in this schedule includes the South Ave. & Onondaga Hill areas. This service includes several routes, which operate at different times of the day depending on travel & employment needs.

- Route 26 South Ave**
This route travels between Downtown Syracuse & South Ave. by way of Onondaga St., South Ave., Bellevue Ave., Onondaga Ave. & South Ave. It then continues on Glenwood Ave. to Corcoran High School.
- Route 126 South Ave - Hospital**
Travels as Route 26 above, except it continues on South Ave. to Upstate University Hospital at Community General.
- Route 226 South Ave - OCC**
Travels like Route 126 listed above, plus it includes service to Onondaga Community College.
- Route 326 South Ave - High Acres**
Travels like Route 226 listed above, plus it includes service to High Acres & the A.H.E.P.A. senior housing complex.
- Route 426 South Ave - Valley Dr**
This route generally operates only during evening hours & on Sundays. It includes South Avenue between West Onondaga Street & Valley Drive, then travels along Valley Drive & Seneca Turnpike to Upstate University Hospital at Community General.
- Route 526 South Ave - Valley Dr - OCC**
Operates like Route 28 listed above, plus it extends to Onondaga Community College.

Most South Avenue trips continue beyond Downtown Syracuse to James St, Eastwood, E. Syracuse & ShoppingTown Mall. The schedule on the reverse of this brochure indicates which trips do so.

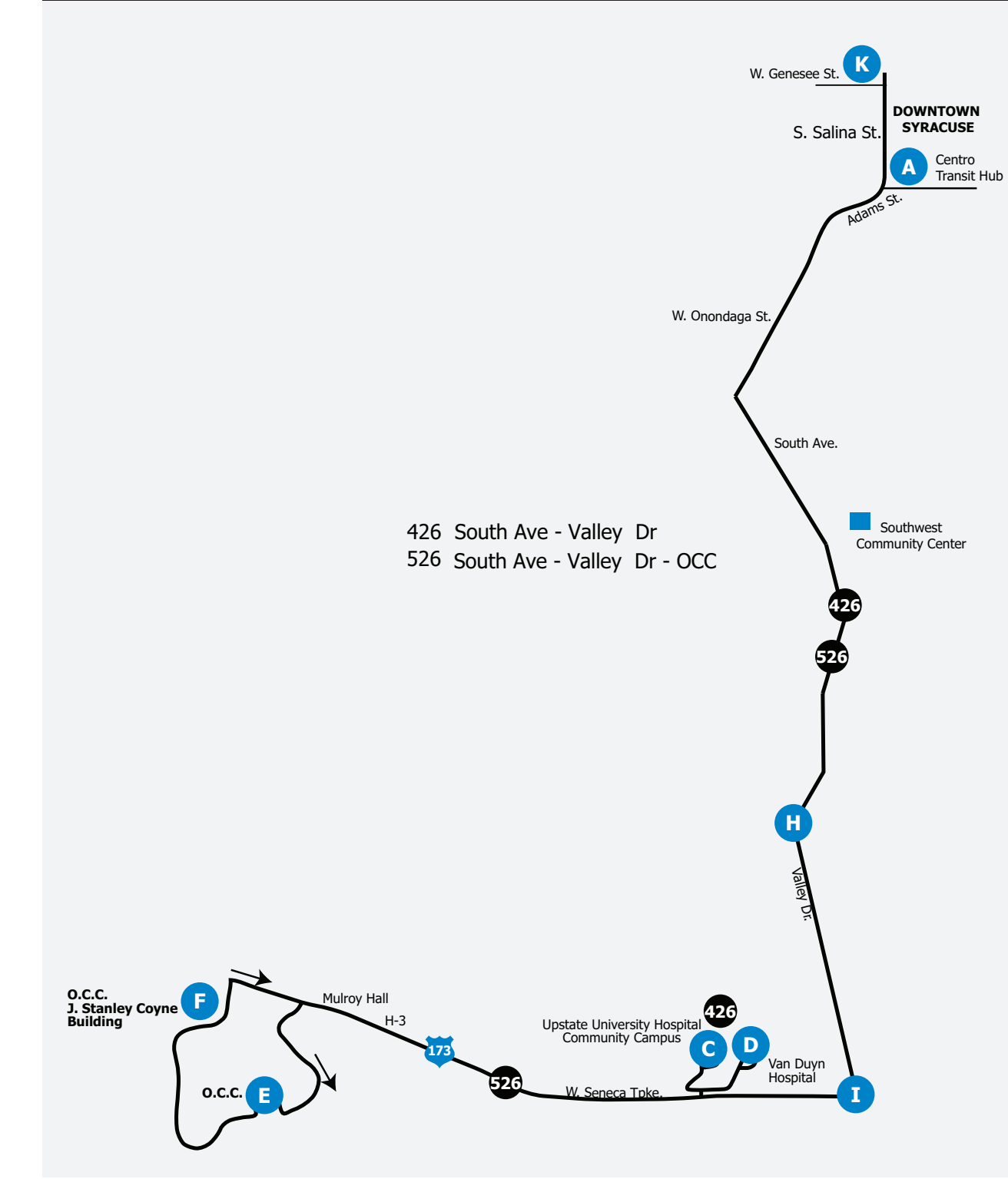

③ - This trip runs when Corcoran H.S. is in session (September - June), for whole or half days and during exams.
④ - This trip may be boarded at South Ave and Brighton Ave.
⑤ - This trip is a "Downtown Express" that bypasses the Hospitals, but will pick up and drop off along the route.

Holiday Service

Buses will operate the Sunday schedule on the following Holidays: New Year's Day (observed), Memorial Day, 4th of July (observed), Labor Day, Thanksgiving, or Christmas (observed). Holidays not listed here will operate on a regular schedule.
